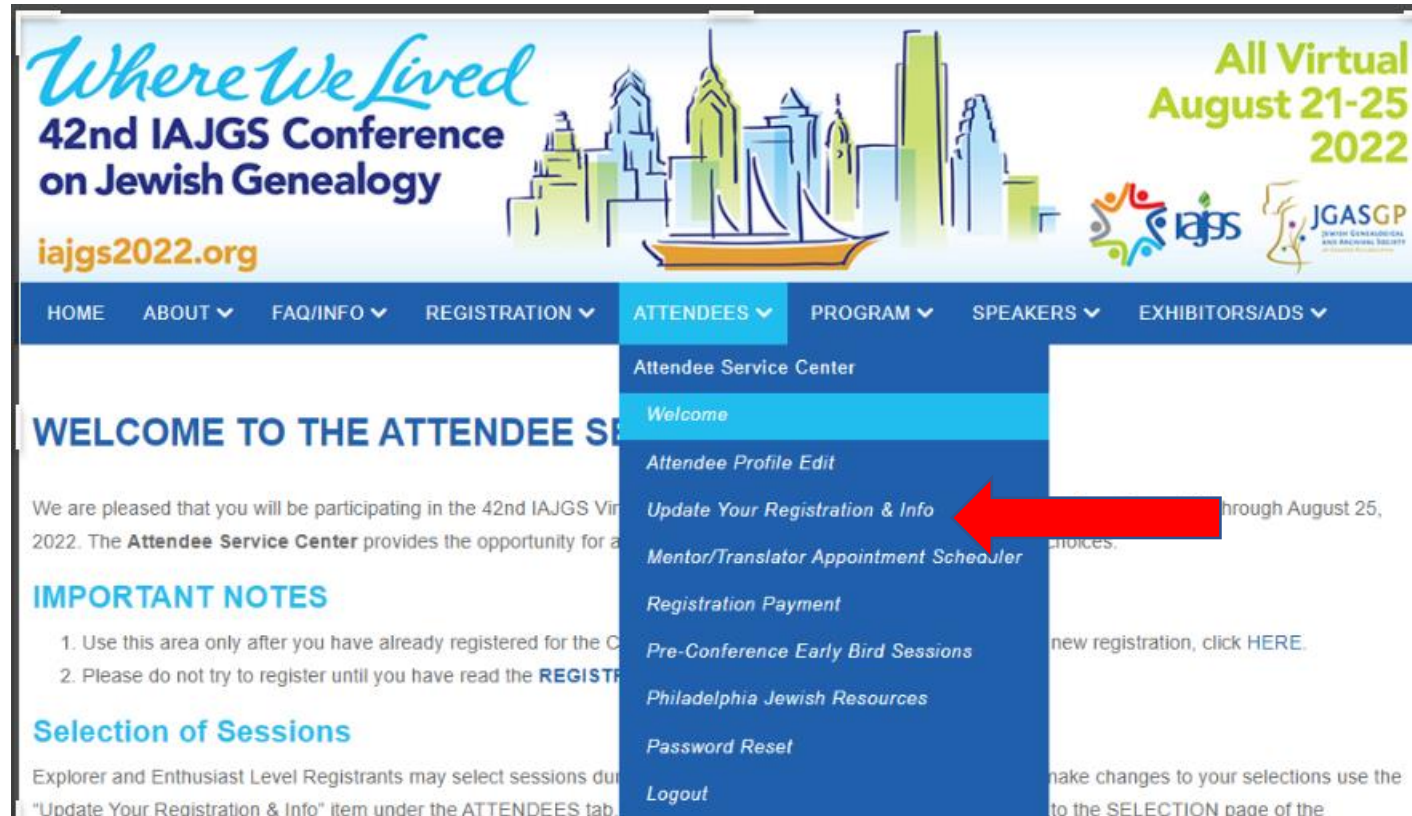

JDC provided life-saving assistance to Jews at these critical points, including the disruptions wrought by World War I, emergency assistance during the Holocaust and care for survivors, and the Aliyah of Jews throughout the Middle East. The JDC Archives has established a prominent online presence, including text collections, photographs, and a names index digitally available via a searchable database. This material is of great interest to Jewish genealogists.</p> <p>This workshop for beginners and intermediate users will focus on basic names search via the Names API and additional database search options, including fuzzy search and full-text search within the text collections.
